Monya Rowe Gallery is pleased to announce a solo exhibition of new paintings by **Bryan Rogers** in the **ONLINE VIEWING ROOM**. The exhibition opens virtually on May 25.

For his first exhibition at Monya Rowe Gallery, **Rogers** presents a suite of six modestly sized paintings. Each vividly colored landscape features men amid dense forests akin to Charles Burchfield (1893-1967). Trees are illuminated in fluorescent green, bright pink and intense blue. The protagonists appear strong and serene in nature as they nestle with flowers, and jog within surreal landscapes. Each tree, plant or flower becomes a character within this journey. With echoes of Marsden Hartley (1877-1943), Rogers is influenced by the inherent patterns and symmetry in nature, architecture, and the body. His highly individualistic work coveys an honest visual style.

Bryan Rogers (b. 1977, Waterbury, CT) received an MFA from *Pratt Institute*, New York, NY and a BFA from *Appalachian State University*, Boone, NC. Recent group exhibitions include *SPRING/BREAK Art Show*, NY; The Hole, NY and *Art Athina Fair*, Athens, Greece. Rogers was co-director of *Honey Ramka Gallery*, Brooklyn from 2013–2019. The artist lives and works in South Orange, NJ.
